### RE: School of Medicine Process for Bridge Funding Applications

As of September 1, 2017, bridge applications are administered, processed, and awarded by the Office of Research. Please see the [guidelines](#) and the Office of Research Internal Research Funding Programs application *form* located at:

School of Medicine applicants may apply, based on need and documented eligibility, for a total maximum of **\$80,000**. When awarded, the Office of Research will provide 60% of each request for bridge funds (i.e., up to \$48,000), the remainder will be divided evenly between the School of Medicine Dean's Office and the investigator's Department (up to \$16,000 each). Contribution from the Office of Research will be based on availability of funds during each fiscal year.

Each request must be accompanied by a letter from the Department Chair committing matching funds towards the bridge funding request, an updated biosketch, reviewers comments from the last grant submission, and a list of past/active awards. The application will be sent to School of Medicine faculty for confidential peer review and recommendations. The School of Medicine Dean's Office will evaluate the faculty reviews and letter of commitment, sign the request if approved, and forward to the UC Davis Office of Research for consideration.
